## **Statement of the Vote Yes for Marblehead Committee**

"The priority of the Vote Yes for Marblehead Committee is <u>solely to help inform voters of the</u> <u>impact the override will have on the towns ability to deliver necessary services.</u>

"Without passage of the override, **33 Positions as well as Programs in Marblehead Public Schools will not be restored**, including:

- Veterans Middle School will **not have a librarian**
- Village School have **2 fewer classroom teachers**, increasing class/team size by as much as 5 students each
- Marblehead High School will have 2 fewer science teachers and 1 less math teacher, driving up class size and overburdening faculty
- There will **not be any freshman athletic teams**, impacting 9 teams and as many as 149 student-athletes

"In addition to the reductions in our schools, we will see significant reductions to Public Safety and other town services, including:

- **3 Firefighter positions will not be restored.** Marblehead is already below recommended staffing levels for a town of our size.
- **2 Police Patrol Positions will not be restored.** Marblehead already has the lowest per capita staffing in Essex County.
- The Highway Department would not restore a heavy equipment operator, further slowing and limiting the Department's ability to improve and maintain our town's critical infrastructure.

"We are focused exclusively on the June 20<sup>th</sup> election and getting the override passed. We often hear community members say how much they love our town, so let's come out and vote like we mean it!"
